The Book Of Revelation

Many Christians avoid the biblical book of Revelation, considering it just too mysterious. Some prefer to



avoid it entirely, often wanting to remove it from the Bible. Others love the book and claim to have figured it all out and see current events as fulfillment of its prophecies. Both of these extremes are misguided. Although there are many bizarre and sometimes disturbing passages, the book was written to provide encouragement for Christians who were treated cruelly or confronted with outright persecution. Its purpose is to help us control our fears of the future and renew our commitment to Jesus Christ.

Join Rev. Stephen Cramer in January and February as we consider the book in its proper context and discover why it forms a proper conclusion to the biblical story.

Ordination and installation of officers will be Sunday, February 23rd during the 11:00 a.m. service.




SESSION RETREAT




