2. Unexpected hugs. 3. Tickle.

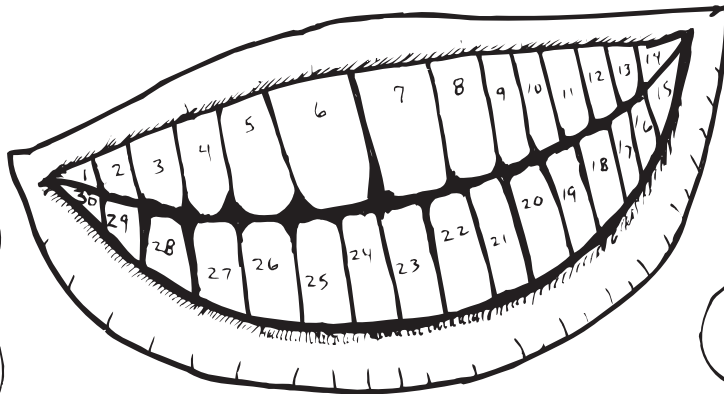

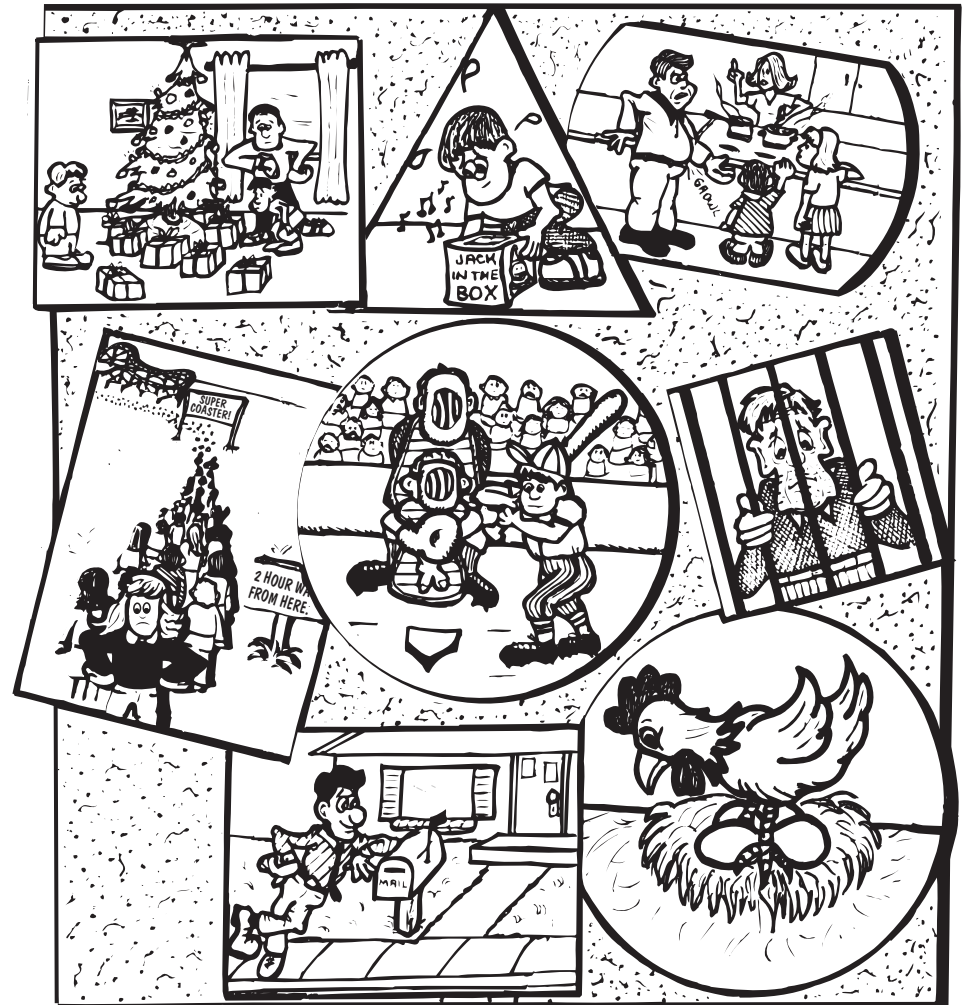

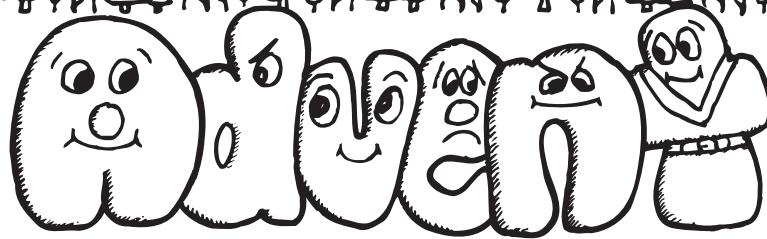
Advent
