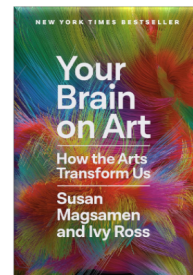

Calvin 2Gether:

1. **FIND:** someone you don't know as well as others and introduce yourself, or discuss with your family around the dinner table.

2. **DISCUSS:** *This week, we ask, "what are we waiting for?" and we learn that what happens within us while we wait is as important as the outcome. Can we be at peace—work for peace—"live peaceably"—even while waiting?*

3. **PRAYER COVENANT:** to pray for each other daily, by name until you meet again (the prayer to the right is offered as a suggestion).
